

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, ADOPTING THE ECONOMIC  
DEVELOPMENT STRATEGIC PLAN

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of League City, Texas (“City”), desires to encourage sustainable economic growth, maintain a financially balanced tax base, and enhance the quality of life for residents and businesses within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City’s Economic Development Department prepared a proposed Economic Development Strategic Plan establishing a five-year framework for economic development priorities, strategic initiatives, implementation goals, and performance metrics; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Economic Development Strategic Plan was developed through community-based strategic planning methods, including outreach and feedback from residents, stakeholders, City staff, and peer review processes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that adoption of the Economic Development Strategic Plan will provide policy guidance for future economic development initiatives, strategic planning efforts, and evaluation of implementation progress; and

WHEREAS, the City Council further finds that the Economic Development Strategic Plan is intended solely as a planning and policy guidance document and does not independently authorize expenditures, contracts, incentives, land use approvals, or regulatory actions, all of which remain subject to future City Council action, appropriations, and applicable law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein for all purposes.

Section 2. The City Council hereby adopts the Economic Development Strategic Plan attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit “A.”

Section 3. The Economic Development Strategic Plan is intended to serve as a policy guidance document for long-term planning purposes. Implementation of specific initiatives identified in the Plan remains subject to future City Council action, funding availability, and applicable law.

Section 3. All resolutions and agreements and parts of resolutions and agreements in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

Section 4. It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.
