A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS,  
AMENDING THE PROGRAM YEAR 2025 ANNUAL ACTION  
PLAN RELATED TO THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT  
BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM; AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION  
OF THE AMENDED PLAN TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF  
HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT; APPROVING  
RELATED PROJECT ELEMENTS

WHEREAS, the City of League City participates in the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program administered by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and adopts an Annual Action Plan to identify the use of such funds; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approved the Program Year (PY) 2025 Annual Action Plan on July 22, 2025, and HUD subsequently approved the plan on October 1, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined, based on updated field conditions, that the Waco Avenue pavement reconstruction project included in the PY 2025 Annual Action Plan is no longer necessary at this time due to satisfactory pavement conditions following prior improvements completed in 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to amend the PY 2025 Annual Action Plan to remove the Waco Avenue pavement project and replace it with a proposed 8-foot pedestrian trail along SH 3 to improve pedestrian mobility and connectivity, particularly for low-to-moderate-income areas; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on March 3, 2026, and a 30-day public comment period was provided in accordance with applicable requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. The City approves the amendment to the Program Year (PY) 2025 Annual Action Plan related to the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, as set forth in **Attachment 1 – 2025 Annual Action Plan Amendment Elements**, attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes.

Section 2. The City approves the replacement of the Waco Avenue pavement reconstruction project with the proposed SH 3 8-foot pedestrian trail project, as generally depicted in **Attachment 2 – Preliminary SH 3 8-Foot Trail Layout**, attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete this transaction.

Section 4. All resolutions and agreements and parts of resolutions and agreements in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

Section 5. It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.
