

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING LANE CLOSURES AND THE
WAIVER OF CITY COSTS RELATED TO THE CHILDREN'S
PARADE - HOLIDAY IN THE PARK EVENT ON DECEMBER
6, 2025, THAT IS SPONSORED BY THE LEAGUE CITY
HISTORICAL SOCIETY

WHEREAS, Section 110-5 of the League City Code of Ordinances requires City Council approval for parade permits involving the closure or use of state or arterial roadways, and the League City Historical Society has submitted the required application and traffic plan; and

WHEREAS, the League City Police Department has reviewed and approved the proposed traffic control plan and confirmed that the event can be supported with City personnel and equipment as outlined in the cost breakdown; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the requested use of public rights-of-way for the Children's Parade – Holiday in the Park is consistent with established procedures governing parades and processions within League City and believes the expenditure of public funds and resources to support the "Children's Parade - Holiday in the Park" to be held December 6, 2025 will serve several public purposes, including: providing safety/security for League City residents and providing economic development to the League City community; and

WHEREAS, by participating in this manner, the City will maintain adequate controls over the use of said City resources to keep League residents safe and support an event which will bring business opportunities, sales tax revenue and hotel/motel tax revenue to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and hereby incorporated into this resolution.

Section 2. The City authorizes lane closures and the waiver of city costs related to the Children's Parade - Holiday in the Park event on December 6, 2025, that is sponsored by the League City Historical Society.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete this transaction.

Section 4. All resolutions and agreements and parts of resolutions and agreements in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

Section 5. It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.
