

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A GROUP CRITICAL ILLNESS INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE TEXAS MUNICIPAL LEAGUE JOINT SELF-INSURANCE FUND FOR ACCESS TO THE TEXAS HOUSE BILL 4144 CRITICAL ILLNESS INSURANCE SOLUTION; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT, STATEMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY, AND A PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT TO BE PROVIDED AT A LATER DATE

WHEREAS, the City of League City, Texas is a home-rule municipality and political subdivision of the State of Texas authorized to enter into interlocal agreements pursuant to Texas Interlocal Cooperation Act; and

WHEREAS, the 89th Texas Legislature enacted House Bill 4144 establishing certain post-retirement critical illness benefit obligations applicable to qualifying political subdivisions for eligible retired firefighters and peace officers; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Municipal League Intergovernmental Risk Pool has developed a Texas House Bill 4144 Critical Illness Insurance Solution and associated interlocal agreement structure intended to facilitate participating political subdivisions' access to critical illness coverage; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that participation in the Texas House Bill 4144 Critical Illness Insurance Solution and execution of the associated agreements serve a valid public purpose and are in the best interests of the City and its employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. The City authorizes a Group Critical Illness Interlocal Agreement with the Texas Municipal League Joint Self-Insurance Fund for access to the Texas House Bill 4144 Critical Illness Insurance Solution; and an executed copy of the agreement shall be attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete this transaction, include the Group Critical Illness Interlocal Agreement, Statement of Responsibility and Participation Agreement.

Section 3. All resolutions and agreements and parts of resolutions and agreements in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

Section 4. It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.
