A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE INSTALLATION OF THREE SPEED HUMPS ALONG CEDAR PRAIRIE DRIVE

WHEREAS, a citizen submitted a request for the installation of three speed humps on Cedar Prairie Drive, a local roadway approximately 1,400 feet in length, as shown in the aerial map attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the request included a letter of no objection from the applicable Homeowners Association and signatures from more than two-thirds of the property owners within the study segment, as set forth in the petition and map attached hereto as Exhibit B; and

WHEREAS, the estimated total cost for the requested speed humps is Five Thousand Three Hundred Sixty and 00/100 Dollars (\$5,360.00), with the cost to be shared equally between the City and the Homeowners Association in accordance with the City's Road Hump Policy adopted in 2019, attached hereto as Exhibit C; and

WHEREAS, the cost estimate for materials and installation of the speed humps was provided to the Homeowners Association president, and the Association confirmed by email that it has no objection to bearing fifty percent of the cost; and

WHEREAS, a speed study was conducted in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, as provided in the speed study report attached hereto as Exhibit D, which found the posted speed limit of twenty-five miles per hour to be within five miles per hour of the estimated eighty-fifth percentile speed; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of League City desires to take action on the request for speed hump installation on Cedar Prairie Drive;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City approves the installation of three speed humps along Cedar Prairie Drive.

<u>Section 2.</u> The City Manager is authorized to execute any document necessary to complete this transaction.

<u>Section 3.</u> All resolutions and agreements and parts of resolutions and agreements in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

<u>Section 4.</u> It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.
