A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT NO. 1
TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH
SANDER ENGINEERING CORPORATION FOR ADDITIONAL
ENGINEERING DESIGN SERVICES FOR THE BAY COLONY
2 PARKSIDE LIFT STATION RELOCATION PROJECT
(WW2601) IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$56,313.00

WHEREAS, the City previously entered into a Professional Services Agreement with Sander Engineering Corporation for design, bid, and construction phase services for the Bay Colony 2 Parkside Lift Station Relocation Project (WW2601) in an amount not to exceed \$247,388.00; and

WHEREAS, coordination with the Texas Department of Transportation and the Bay Colony Parkside Homeowners Association resulted in the selection of a proposed alternative location requiring additional surveying, geotechnical investigation, utility easement preparation, and engineering design services; and

WHEREAS, the change in the proposed lift station location requires additional engineering, surveying, geotechnical, bid phase, and construction administration services to complete the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated into this Resolution for all purposes.

Section 2. The City authorizes Amendment No. 1 to the Professional Services Agreement with Sander Engineering Corporation for additional engineering design services for the Bay Colony 2 Parkside Lift Station Relocation Project (WW2601) in an amount not to exceed \$56,313.00, increasing the total compensation under the Agreement to an amount not to exceed \$303,701.00; and an executed copy of the amendment shall be attached as Exhibit A.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete this transaction.

Section 4. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution was adopted was open to the public and that public notice of the time, place, and subject matter of the meeting was given as required by Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
