Tree Preservation Requirement Changes – One-Sheet Summary

This sheet contrasts League City's existing Tree Preservation rules with the proposed Amendments. It is written for City Council members, developers, and consultants who need a quick reference.

Key Takeaways

- Planning Director can permit removal of up to 10% of big tree (Oak/Pecan ≥ 38") caliper inches administratively under certain conditions. Removals above 10% and up to 25% require a simple majority City Council sign-off.
- Any development may remove up to 10% of protected caliper inches on site with no replacement or fee required.
- Illegal removal would incur the in-lieu fee plus 100% penalty instead of the 200% penalty.
- Total tree related charges (fees + restitution) cannot exceed 30% of the unimproved land's appraised value if site is properly permitted. If site is cleared without a permit, total tree-related chargers can increase to 50% of the unimproved land value to reflect the severity of the violation.
- Appeals to the City Manager now suspend all fines while under review and establishes a 30-day window for appeal review.
