  - Proof of Payment
    - Copies of Signed Check(s)
    - Credit Card Receipt(s)
    - Paid Vendor Invoice(s) showing the last 4 digits of credit card used
    - Bank/Credit Card Statement(s) Showing the Purchase
- 3. Texas A&M Forest Service will then issue a reimbursement check or direct deposit of 90% of the cost, up to the specified amount shown on the approval notice.
- 4. Grants for PPE will expire **6 months** from the approval date. Extensions may be available upon request via <u>FireConnect</u>.

- 2. Submit for Reimbursement via FireConnect, and upload the following supporting documents:
  - Proof of Payment
    - Copies of Signed Check(s)
    - Credit Card Receipt(s)
    - Paid Vendor Invoice(s) showing the last 4 digits of credit card used
    - Bank/Credit Card Statement(s) Showing the Purchase
- 3. Grants for fire/rescue equipment will expire **6 months** from the approval date. Extensions may be available upon request via <u>FireConnect</u>.
