

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING (1) A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH TRAFFIC SYSTEMS CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE MAPLE LEAF DRIVE AND LEAGUE CITY PARKWAY TRAFFIC SIGNAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (ST2403) IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$725,926.05; (2) A WORK CHANGE DIRECTIVE BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$72,593.00; (3) A CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL TESTING SERVICES CONTRACT WITH UES PROFESSIONAL SOLUTIONS 44, LLC IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$15,049.00; AND (4) A TOTAL PROJECT BUDGET OF \$813,568.05

WHEREAS, the City has identified the need for traffic signal improvements at the intersection of Maple Leaf Drive and League City Parkway due to increased traffic volumes associated with current and anticipated growth, including connectivity to the City of Friendswood; and

WHEREAS, the project scope includes installation of a mast-arm traffic signal with pedestrian crossing features and the addition of a northbound right-turn lane on Maple Leaf Drive and a westbound right-turn lane on League City Parkway to improve safety and traffic operations; and

WHEREAS, the City solicited competitive sealed bids for the Maple Leaf Drive and League City Parkway Traffic Signal Improvements Project (ST2403) under Bid No. 26-015, and four (4) bids were received on March 26, 2026; and

WHEREAS, Traffic Systems Construction, Inc. has submitted the lowest responsible and responsive project and the City Council finds that the selection of Traffic Systems Construction is in the best interest of the City and consistent with applicable procurement requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. The City authorizes a construction contract with Traffic Systems Construction, Inc. for the Maple Leaf Drive and League City Parkway Traffic Signal Improvements Project (ST2403) in an amount not to exceed \$725,926.05; and an executed copy of the agreement shall be attached as **Exhibit A**.

Section 2. The City authorizes a Work Change Directive budget in the amount of **\$72,593.00** for the project.

Section 3. The City authorizes a construction material testing services contract with UES Professional Solutions 44, LLC, attached hereto as **Exhibit B**

Section 4. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete this transaction.

Section 5. All resolutions and agreements and parts of resolutions and agreements in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

Section 6. It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.
