

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A THREE-YEAR AGREEMENT WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS HEALTH SCIENCE CENTER AT HOUSTON FOR EMPLOYEE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM SERVICES THROUGH UTEAP FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$59,184

WHEREAS, the City of League City desires to provide employee assistance program services for the benefit of its employees and eligible volunteer firefighters through confidential assessment, referral, counseling, and related support services; and

WHEREAS, The University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston, through UTEAP, provides employee assistance program services, including counseling, work/life resources, training, and related support services; and

WHEREAS, City staff evaluated employee assistance program provider options and determined that continuing services with UTEAP provides the best value to the City through continuity of services, employee familiarity, and ongoing program utilization; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that authorizing a three-year agreement with The University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston for employee assistance program services through UTEAP for an amount not to exceed \$59,184 is in the best interest of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein for all purposes.

Section 2. The City hereby authorizes a three-year Agreement for Employee Assistance Program Services with The University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston through UTEAP for an amount not to exceed \$59,184, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference for all purposes.

Section 3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement and all related documents necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution.

Section 4. All resolutions and agreements and parts of resolutions and agreements in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

Section 5. It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.
