

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, REQUESTING GRANT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM THE TEXAS WATER DEVELOPMENT BOARD IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$9,000,000 FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE WT1910 LEAGUE CITY PARKWAY WEST WATER PLANT PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, House Bill 500, enacted by the 89th Texas Legislature, appropriated funds to the Texas Water Development Board for eligible water supply and infrastructure projects; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Water Development Board established the Water Supply and Infrastructure Grant Program to provide grant funding for eligible water supply and infrastructure projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of League City has identified the WT1910 League City Parkway West Water Plant Project as a necessary water supply and infrastructure project; and

WHEREAS, the Project generally includes construction of a new water well, ground storage tank, booster pump station, chemical feed and SCADA systems, generator, electrical improvements, yard piping, and related site improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that submitting an application for grant funding for the Project is in the public interest and will support the City's long-term water supply and infrastructure needs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated into this Resolution for all purposes.

Section 2. The City requests grant financial assistance from the Texas Water Development Board through the Water Supply and Infrastructure Grant Program in an amount not to exceed \$9,000,000 for construction of the WT1910 League City Parkway West Water Plant Project. The filing of the City's application for such financial assistance is approved and authorized.

Section 3. The City Manager, or designee, is designated as the City's authorized representative and is authorized to furnish information, submit the application, accept and administer any resulting grant award, and execute all related documents necessary to complete the transaction.

Section 4. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution was adopted was open to the public and that public notice of the time, place, and subject matter of the meeting was given as required by Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
