

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH KIMLEY-HORN TO PREPARE A PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING REPORT (PER) FOR THE FM 518 STREET LIGHTING FROM IH 45 TO FM 270 INTERSECTION PROJECT (ST2603) IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$72,500; AND PROVIDING FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the City of League City, Texas (the "City") seeks to analyze and evaluate street lighting needs along the FM 518 corridor from IH 45 to FM 270; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project includes the potential installation of decorative streetlight/banner poles, luminaires, conduit, and wiring along an approximately 13,000-foot corridor; and

WHEREAS, Kimley-Horn has been selected to provide professional engineering services for this project and has submitted a proposal outlining tasks and fees in an amount not to exceed \$72,500; and

WHEREAS, this project supports the City's Strategic Planning Critical Success Factor #1: Develop and Maintain our Infrastructure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. The City hereby authorizes a professional services agreement with Kimley-Horn to prepare a Preliminary Engineering Report (PER) for the FM 518 Street Lighting from IH 45 to FM 270 Intersection Project (ST2603) in an amount not to exceed \$72,500, substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to negotiate, execute, and deliver all necessary agreements, purchase orders, and related documents, and to take all actions necessary to implement the intent of this resolution.

Section 3. All resolutions and agreements and parts of resolutions and agreements in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

Section 4. It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
