

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A THREE-YEAR AGREEMENT WITH CODEMANTRA U.S. LLC TO PROVIDE ELECTRONIC DOCUMENT REMEDIATION SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$450,000; AND AUTHORIZING TWO SUBSEQUENT ONE-YEAR RENEWALS, IF DEEMED NECESSARY

WHEREAS, title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (“ADA”) applies to State and local government entities; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Justice (“Department”) issued its final rule, effective June 24, 2024, revising the regulation implementing title II of the ADA to establish specific requirements, including the adoption of specific technical standards, for making accessible the services, programs, and activities offered by State and local government entities to the public through their web and mobile applications; and

WHEREAS, the Department adopted the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (“WCAG”) 2.1, as the technical standard for web content and mobile applications accessibility; and

WHEREAS, the technical standards were incorporated in title II of the ADA under Subpart H, entitled “Web and Mobile Accessibility”, and requires compliance with Level A and Level AA success criteria and conformance requirements as specified in WCAG 2.1; and

WHEREAS, a public entity with a total population of 50,000 or more, which includes the City of League City, shall comply with the requirements beginning on April 24, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City of League City enters into this agreement to ensure the web content that the City of League City provides, or makes available, complies with Level A and Level AA success criteria and conformance requirements as specified in WCAG 2.1.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein for all purposes.

Section 2. The City authorizes a three-year agreement with Codemantra U.S. LLC to provide electronic document remediation services in an amount not to exceed \$450,000; and authorizes two subsequent one-year renewals, if deemed necessary; and an executed copy of the agreement shall be attached as Exhibit A.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete this transaction.

Section 4. All resolutions and agreements and parts of resolutions and agreements in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

Section 5. It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was

passed was open to the public and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.
