

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH RAM ROD UTILITIES, LLC FOR THE DAVIS ROAD 15-INCH GRAVITY SEWER REPLACEMENT PROJECT (WW1801K) IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$378,535.00; AUTHORIZING A WORK CHANGE DIRECTIVE BUDGET OF \$37,853.00; AND PROVIDING FOR A TOTAL CONSTRUCTION BUDGET NOT TO EXCEED \$416,388.00

WHEREAS, the City seeks to replace approximately 550 linear feet of existing 15-inch gravity sewer along Davis Road and rehabilitate three existing sanitary sewer manholes as part of the Davis Road 15-Inch Gravity Sewer Replacement Project (WW1801K); and

WHEREAS, the City received three sealed bids for the Project under Bid No. 2026-044, and Ram Rod Utilities, LLC submitted the lowest responsible and responsive bid under the City's stated A+B bidding methodology, with a construction price of \$378,535.00 and a contract time of 105 calendar days; and

WHEREAS, the City's engineering consultant has reviewed the bids and recommends awarding the construction contract to Ram Rod Utilities, LLC

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated into this Resolution for all purposes.

Section 2. The City authorizes a construction contract with Ram Rod Utilities, LLC for the Davis Road 15-Inch Gravity Sewer Replacement Project (WW1801K) in an amount not to exceed \$378,535.00; and an executed copy of the amendment shall be attached as Exhibit A. The City also authorizes an additional \$37,853.00 for a Work Change Directive budget for a total construction budget of \$416,388.00.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete this transaction.

Section 4. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution was adopted was open to the public and that public notice of the time, place, and subject matter of the meeting was given as required by Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
