

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS,
AUTHORIZING A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE
INTERLOCAL MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY
OF DICKINSON FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City of League City, Texas (“City”) and the City of Dickinson, Texas entered into an Interlocal Mutual Aid Agreement for Emergency Medical Services executed October 1, 2020, pursuant to Resolution No. 2020-138 (the “Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, the Agreement provides for mutual aid in the delivery of emergency medical services and establishes that the requesting party shall reimburse the providing party for the deployment and use of emergency medical resources as set forth in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the City has experienced a significant increase in mutual aid responses to the City of Dickinson, and the reimbursement rates established in Exhibit A have not been updated since 2020 and no longer reflect the City’s actual costs of maintaining EMS readiness and operational capacity; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the updated reimbursement rates are intended to recover the City’s costs associated with personnel, equipment, and operational impacts resulting from the increased volume of mutual aid responses, and that such rates are separate from and in addition to any patient billing for medical services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. The City authorizes a First Amendment to the Interlocal Mutual Aid Agreement with the City of Dickinson for Emergency Medical Services, attached hereto as **Exhibit A** and incorporated herein by reference, which updates the readiness (standby) reimbursement rates as follows:

- Non-Transport Response: \$375.00 per call
- Transport Response: \$1,700.00 per transport

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete this transaction.

Section 3. All resolutions and agreements and parts of resolutions and agreements in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

Section 4. It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.
