Re: Request for Dissolution of Galveston County Municipal Utility District No. 14

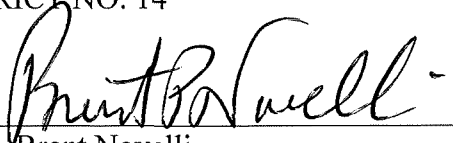
Dear City Council Members:

Please accept this letter as the formal request of the Board of Directors of Galveston County Municipal Utility District No. 14 (the "District") that the City of League City, Texas (the "City") dissolve the District within ninety (90) days after the last debt-service payment made by the District on October 1, 2025. The District and the City are parties to that certain Restated Utility Agreement dated January 22, 1999, as amended (the "RUA"). Pursuant to the RUA, the District is an "in-City" municipal utility district which has served as a financial vehicle for the development within the boundaries of the District. Under this structure, all water, sanitary sewer, and drainage facilities have been conveyed by the District to the City for ownership, operation and maintenance. The District does not own and/or operate any such facilities. After the District made the October 1, 2025 debt-service payment, there is no reason for the District to continue to exist.
