The purpose of the grant is to enhance public safety by funding the acquisition of movable vehicle barrier systems that help prevent unauthorized vehicle access, protect pedestrians in high-traffic areas, and support secure traffic control during special events and temporary roadway closures.				
<b>Items the Grant Will Pay For</b>				
Grant funds will be used to purchase movable, purpose-built vehicle barrier systems designed to stop or deter unauthorized vehicle access in areas with high pedestrian activity. Eligible costs may include the acquisition of portable barrier units, associated transport or deployment components, and related equipment necessary to support safe and efficient installation, operation, and storage. These systems will enhance event security, traffic control, and pedestrian protection during special events and temporary street closures, subject to grant guidelines and approval.
