

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH GFT INFRASTRUCTURE, INC. FOR ENGINEERING, SURVEYING, EASEMENT ACQUISITION SUPPORT, BIDDING, AND CONSTRUCTION PHASE SERVICES ASSOCIATED WITH THE EXTENSION OF A 24-INCH WATERLINE ALONG FM 517

WHEREAS, the City of League City has identified the need to extend a 24-inch waterline along FM 517 from approximately 900 feet west of Calder Road to approximately 700 feet east of Pedregal Boulevard to support long-term water system capacity, reliability, and future growth; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project is consistent with the City's Master Water Plan and capital improvement planning efforts and will enhance the City's water distribution infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, GFT Infrastructure, Inc. has submitted a proposal to provide engineering design, surveying, easement acquisition support, bidding assistance, and construction phase services necessary for implementation of the project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that approval of the Professional Services Agreement will serve a public purpose and promote the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of League City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. The City authorizes a Professional Services Agreement with GFT Infrastructure, Inc. in an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Forty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$345,000) for engineering, surveying, easement acquisition support, bidding, and construction phase services associated with the extension of a 24-inch waterline along FM 517 from approximately 900 feet west of Calder Road to approximately 700 feet east of Pedregal Boulevard; and an executed copy of the agreement shall be attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete this transaction.

Section 3. All resolutions and agreements and parts of resolutions and agreements in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

Section 4. It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.
