

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF HOUSTON RELATED TO THE FIFA WORLD CUP GRANT PROGRAM FOR REGIONAL PUBLIC SAFETY SUPPORT SERVICES

WHEREAS, Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code, known as the Interlocal Cooperation Act, authorizes local governments to contract with one another to perform governmental functions and services; and

WHEREAS, the Fédération Internationale de Football Association (“FIFA”) has selected Houston as a host city for matches and related activities associated with the 2026 FIFA World Cup, which is anticipated to increase regional public safety, emergency management, hazardous materials response, and bomb squad operational demands; and

WHEREAS, the City of Houston has requested regional support from participating public safety agencies, including the Bay Area Regional Bomb Squad and Hazardous Materials (“HazMat”) resources operated or supported by the City of League City, and grant funding has been awarded to support eligible event-related public safety expenditures, including overtime costs for authorized personnel; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that entering into the interlocal agreement with the City of Houston related to the FIFA World Cup Grant Program will promote regional coordination and support public safety operations associated with the event and serves a public purpose;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein for all purposes.

Section 2. The City hereby authorizes the Interlocal Agreement between the City of League City and the City of Houston related to the FIFA World Cup Grant Program, attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and incorporated herein by reference for all purposes.

Section 3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Interlocal Agreement and all related documents necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution.

Section 4. All resolutions and agreements and parts of resolutions and agreements in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

Section 5. It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.
