West Bay Common School Children's Museum is planning our annual Children's Parade. In past years this parade has taken place on July 4th and was known as the Teddy Bear Parade. For the comfort and safety of volunteers and guests the Board Members of the League City Historical Society decided to move the parade to a month with cooler temperatures.

The walking parade through the Historic District will take place on October 12th starting at 10am. We will line up at the Museum (beginning at 9am) and parade down to League Park where the League City Parks and Recreation Department will be hosting the annual Fall Festival. We will meet with them to coordinate our efforts.

With the intention of keeping everyone as safe as possible, we are submitting a street closure application. Last year we worked with the LCPD to close off Kansas as we were lining up (9 to 10) and then as we walked down 2nd Street they just assisted us with closing the cross streets as we went to keep everyone safe. It worked great and caused no issue for the neighborhood.

Because we are a non-profit organization that is offering this event free of charge to the community we are asking the council waive the fees associated with setting up barricades to block off streets during this time.
