

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE OF AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$796,900.00 WITH READY POWER LLC FOR THE PURCHASE OF FOUR GENERATORS UTILIZING FEMA HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM FUNDING

WHEREAS, by adoption of Resolution No. 2021-127, the City Council previously authorized the application for and acceptance of grant funding in the amount of \$1,096,658.46 through the FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) DR-4572, PW009 Grant for the purchase and installation of permanent backup generators at critical City facilities; and

WHEREAS, on January 16, 2026, the City issued Invitation to Bid (ITB) 26-027 for Emergency Generators in accordance with federal procurement requirements applicable to HMGP-funded projects, and four (4) responses were received on February 4, 2026; and

WHEREAS, due to the delivery deadline of June 1, 2026, imposed by the HMGP grant, bids that could not meet the required timeline were rejected for justifiable reasons pursuant to 2 C.F.R. § 200.320(b)(1)(e), leaving Ready Power LLC as the only responsive and responsible bidder capable of meeting the grant requirements; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of the four (4) permanent backup generators will enhance the City's ability to maintain continuity of critical operations and services during power outages and directly supports the City's Strategic Planning Critical Success Factor #1 to Develop and Maintain Infrastructure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEAGUE CITY, TEXAS, as follows:

Section 1. The City authorizes an expenditure in an amount not to exceed Seven Hundred Ninety-Six Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$796,900.00) with Ready Power LLC for the purchase of four (4) emergency generators utilizing FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funding.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete this transaction.

Section 3. All resolutions and agreements and parts of resolutions and agreements in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict only.

Section 4. It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public and that advance public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by law.
